

VMHB TENNIS POLICY – COVID 19*1

TEMPORARY POLICY-EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY MAY 29, 2020

Please be advised the following *guidelines* were approved by the BOD on <u>June 16, 2020</u> to the VMHB Tennis/Pickleball Court Policy. This policy *supersedes* the VMHB Tennis policy until further NOTICE. Link below.

- 1. Do not play if sick.
- 2. Court time **must be reserved** on the VMHB website. So that everyone may play, please do not exceed standard game time of 1 hour, 30 minutes.

- 3. NO CHILDREN under 19 are permitted to use the courts.
- 4. Do not use the courts if under 14-day travel-related or other quarantine mandated by Rhode Island law or executive order.
- 5. Wash or disinfect hands prior to entry and after play.
- 6. Wipe lock box, key and gate latch with disinfectant. Staff will do this in the morning.
- 7. Guests are only permitted if they are playing with a resident and the resident takes responsibility that any guests will follow VMHB rules stated here.
- 8. Do not use scorecards, rather keep your own score until COVID-19 restrictions ease.
- 9. If ALL above rules are followed, doubles tennis and pickleball may proceed.

*Temporary Guidelines to be practiced during Covid-19 crisis<u>: Any rules provided by the Board</u> of VMHB are subject to any R.I. state guidelines which take preference.
