RECOMMENDED LANDSCAPE STANDARDS

The following Landscape Standards listed below are compatible with this site*, and therefore, acknowledged to be acceptable in most landscape plantings. The attached information is to be used as a guide for all Substantial Landscape Modifications, in conjunction with agreed landscape requirements and landscape policies, adopted in 2011. Recommendations are geared to protect residents' views with dwarf and compact species.

***= species has proven to survive well on this windswept site. DWY= Driveway Tree
(**= UNACCEPTABLE for site: either proven, invasive, tall/fast growth, or not adjacent to Bay)**

TREES: (EVERGREEN) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL NAME

1. *Dwarf Alberta Spruce – *Picea Glauca* 'Conica' – protection recommended.
2. Dwarf Blue Spruce – *Picea pungens* 'Baby Blue Eyes'
3. Compact Blue Spruce – *Picea pungens* 'Bakeri'
4. Dwarf Black Pine – *Pinus thunbergii* 'Thunderhead'
5. *Dwarf Weeping White Pine – *Pinus strobus* 'Nana'
6. *Boulevard Cypress – *Chamaecyparis pisifera* 'Boulevard' -protection recommended.
7. Dwarf Serbian Spruce – *Picea omorika* 'Pimoko'

TREES: (DECIDUOUS) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL NAME

1. *River Birch clump & single trunk– *Betula nigra* 'Heritage,' - **DWY**
2. *Dwarf Japanese Maple – *Acer palmatum* 'Rhode Island Red'
3. Compact Japanese Maple – *Acer palmatum* 'Shishigashira'
4. *Pee Gee Hydrangea Tree – *Hydrangea paniculata grandiflora* – protection recommended.
5. *Dwarf Japanese Maple, Threadleaf – *Acer palmatum dissectum*, ALL

TREES: (FLOWERING) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL NAME

1. *Chinese Lilac - *Syringa reticulata* 'Ivory Silk' - **DWY**
2. *Ornamental Pear – *Pyrus calleryana* 'Red Spire' - **DWY**
3. *Chinese Dogwood – *Cornus kousa* 'Satomi' - **DWY**
4. *Serviceberry – *Amelanchier canadensis* 'Robin Hill'
5. *Clump Lilac – *Syringa chinensis* 'Lilac Sunday'
6. Clump French Lilac - *Syringa x prestoniae* 'James MacFarlane'
7. *Dwarf Korean Lilac – *Syringa meyeri* 'Palibin' – protection recommended.
8. *Dwarf Fairytale Series Lilac - *Syringa bailbelle* 'Tinkerbelle' – protection recommended.
9. *Magnolia, Star - *Magnolia stellata* 'Royal Star'
10. *Compact Sargent Crabapple – *Malus sargentii* (small berries)
11. *Compact Crabapple – *Malus* 'Prairifire'
12. Purple Smoke Tree – *Cotinus coggygria* 'Royal Purple,' 'Grace'
12. Redbud clump or single trunk – *Cercis chinensis* 'Forest Pansy'
13. Thornless Hawthorn – *Crataegus crusgalli v. intermis* 'Snowbird'

SHRUBS: (DWARF EVERGREEN) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Euonymous – Euonymous 'Moonshadow,' 'Emerald Gaiety' – part sun, medium soil
2. *Blue Junipers – Juniperus squamata 'Blue Star,' horizontalis 'Bar Harbor,' - sun, medium soil
3. *Shore Juniper – Juniperus conferta 'Blue Pacific' – sun/part sun, medium soil
4. *Mugho Pine – Pinus mugo x 'Pumilio' – sun, medium soil
5. *Garden Juniper – Juniperus procumbens 'Nana' – sun, medium soil
6. Dwarf Golden Arborvitae (Cedar) – Thuja 'Tom Thumb' – sun, medium soil
7. Dwarf Globe Cedar – Thuja occidentalis 'Little Giant' – sun, medium soil
8. *Dwarf Globe White Pine – Pinus strobus 'Blue Shag' – sun, medium soil
9. *Heller Holly – Ilex crenata 'Hellerii' – shade/part shade, rich soil, even moisture, protection

SHRUBS: (DWARF EVERGREEN/FLOWERING) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Cotoneaster – Cotoneaster dammeri 'Lowfast,' 'Coral Beauty,' 'Tom Thumb' - sun, medium soil
2. Dwarf Skimmia, female – Skimmia japonica, female – shade, rich soil, protection
3. Dwarf Skimmia, male – Skimmia japonica, male – shade, rich soil, protection
4. Dwarf Japanese Andromeda – Pieris japonica yak. 'Cavatine' – part shade, protection
5. *Rhododendron – Rhododendron 'Yaku' – part sun/ moist, rich soil, good drainage, protection

SHRUBS: (DWARF DECIDUOUS/ FLOWERING) – COMMON NAME – BOTANICAL – EXPOSURE

1. *Hydrangea, Dwarf hybrids for pots and small gardens, ALL – shade, part sun, rich, moist soil
2. *Dwarf Rose – Rosa landscape, 'Flower Carpet' series, ALL – sun, rich soil, medium moisture
3. *Dwarf Weigelia – Weigelia – 'Minuet,' 'Midnight Wine' ALL – part sun, medium soil
4. *Dwarf Deutzia – Deutzia gracilis 'Nikko' – part sun, rich soil
5. *Dwarf Spirea – Dwarf Spirea hybrids – 'Magic Carpet,' 'Golden Elf,' 'Little Princess' – sun
6. *Viburnum, Everblooming Dwarf – Viburnum plicatum tom. 'Watanabei' – sun, rich soil, protection
7. *Hydrangea, Everblooming Dwarf – Hydrangea mac. 'Twist & Shout' – part shade, protection

SHRUBS: (COMPACT EVERGREEN) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Compact Inkberry – Ilex glabra compacta, 'Shamrock,' – sun/part sun
2. Compact Andorra Juniper – Juniperus horizontalis 'Plumosa Youngstown' – sun
3. *Euonymous variegated leaf upright – Euonymous 'Silver King' – part shade, moist soil
4. Compact Little-leaf Holly – Ilex crenata 'Compacta' – part sun, medium soil, protection
5. *Dwarf Blue Spruce Globe – Picea pungens 'Glauca Globosa' – sun, medium soil
6. Boxwood, variegated – Buxus, variegata – part sun, rich soil, protection
7. *Japanese Variegated Euonymous – Euonymous japonica 'Butterscotch' – part sun, protection

SHRUBS: (COMPACT EVERGREEN/FLOWERING) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Japanese Andromeda, Variegated – Pieris japonica 'Flaming Silver' – part shade, protection
2. *PJM rhododendron, compact – Rhododendron PJM 'Elite' – part sun, rich soil
3. Coast Leucothoe – Leucothoe axillaris compacta, ALL – part sun, moist soil, protection
4. *PJM rhododendron – Rhododendron 'PJM compacta' – part sun/ rich soil
5. *Compact Rhododendron – Rhododendron 'Chionoides' – part shade, moist soil, protection
6. *Cherry Laurel – Prunus laurel 'Otto' – gets wide – shade, rich soil, moist, protection
7. *PJM Rhododendron – PJM 'Ramapo' – part shade/ rich soil, medium moisture, protection
8. Compact Japanese Andromeda – Pieris compacta – part sun, rich soil, protection
9. *Compact Mountain Laurel – Kalmia latifolia 'Elf,' – mostly shade, rich, moist soil, protection

SHRUBS: (DECIDUOUS COMPACT/MEDIUM) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Butterfly Bush – Buddleia, ALL – sun, sandy soil (May Need Staking)
2. *Beach Rose – Rosa rugosa 'Explorer' hybrids, ALL – 'Jen's Munk' – sandy soil
3. *Rose – Rosa – 'Knock-Out' series, ALL – 'Rainbow,' 'Double Pink' – sun, rich soil
4. *Bluebeard Shrub – Caryopteris – ALL – 'Worcester Gold,' 'Petite Bleu' – sun, dry/medium soil
5. *Hydrangea, Lacecap – Hydrangea, ALL – 'Blue Wave' – shade/part shade, rich soil
6. *Hydrangea, Mophead – Hydrangea macrofolium, ALL – part shade, moist soil
7. *Hydrangea, Annabelle – Hydrangea arborescens, ALL – 'Annabelle' – shade/part sun, moist soil
8. *Potentilla – Potentilla fruticosa- 'Pink Beauty,' 'Abbotswood,' 'Primrose Beauty' – sun, medium soil
9. *Winterberry – Ilex verticillata – 'Berry Heavy,' 'Afterglow' – sun, medium soil
10. *Compact Summersweet – Clethra alnifolia – 'Hummingbird' – sun, medium soil
11. *Fothergilla – Fothergilla major – 'Mt. Airy' – part shade, protection

SHRUBS: (DECIDUOUS/TALL) – COMMON NAME – BOTANICAL – EXPOSURE

1. *Rose-of-Sharon – Hibiscus syriacus – 'Aphrodite,' 'Diana,' 'Blue Satin'
2. *Compact European Cranberry – Viburnum opulus 'Compacta' – part sun, rich soil
3. *Autumn Hydrangea, clump shape – Hydrangea grandiflora 'Pinky Winky,' 'Vanilla Strawberry'
4. *Endless Summer Hydrangea – Hydrangea 'Endless Summer' ALL – shade/part sun, moist soil
5. *Rose, climbing – Rosa climber – ALL SLOW growers, sun, moist soil, protection
6. *Sand Cherry – Prunus cistina – sun, sandy soil, medium moisture
7. *Summersweet – Clethra alnifolia, ALL – 'Ruby Spice' – sun, medium soil
8. *False Indigo – Baptisia australis – shade/ part shade, medium soil
9. *Spice Viburnum – Viburnum carlesii 'Compactum' – part shade, medium soil
10. *Gold-Twig Dogwood – Cornus sericea 'Silver & Gold' – variegated – part sun, moist soil
11. *Red-Twig Dogwood – Cornus alba, 'Ivory Halo' – variegated – part sun, moist soil, protection

PERENNIALS: (EVERGREEN/LOW) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Winter Heath – Erica carnea 'Springwood Pink, Springwood White' – sun/part sun, sandy soil
2. Bergenia - Bergenia cordifolia – shade/ moist soil, protection

PERENNIALS: (DECIDUOUS/ LOW) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Sedum – Sedum – ALL – hot/dry/sun, good drainage
2. Spring Heather – Calluna vulgaris, ALL – sun, sandy soil

PERENNIALS: (SHORT/MEDIUM) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Plantain Lily – Hosta, ALL – shade, moist soil
2. *Daylily – Hemerocallis – sun/part sun /medium moisture - (ALL but **HEMEROCALLIS FULVA)
3. *Lavender – Lavandula, ALL – hot/dry, sun, good drainage
4. *Black-Eyed Susan – Rudbeckia, 'Goldstrum,' 'Prairie Sun' – sun/partial sun / medium moisture
5. *Sedum – Sedum, ALL – hot/dry, sun/part sun, good drainage
6. *Chrysanthemum – Dendranthema - sun/part sun - (ALL but **FEVERFEW)
7. *Artemisia, silver – ONLY Artemisia 'Powis Castle,' 'Silver Mound,' (READ **INVASIVE LIST)
8. *Meadow Sage – Salvia nemerosa 'May Night,' 'East Freisland,' – sun/part sun, medium soil
9. *Tickseed – Coreopsis verticillata 'Moonbeam,' 'Zagreb' (READ **INVASIVE LIST)
10. *Coneflower – Echinacea 'Kim's Knee High' – sun, medium soil (READ **INVASIVE LIST)
11. *Gayfeather – Liatris spicata, 'Kobold' – sun, medium soil
12. *Lady's Mantle - Alchemilla mollis – part shade, medium soil
13. *Thrift – Armeria maritima – sun, sandy soil.
14. *Astilbe – Astilbe, ALL – shade, rich, moist soil – protection
15. *Gaura – Gaura, ALL – sun/part sun, rich soil, protection
16. *Coral Bells – Heuchera, ALL – shade, rich, moist soil, protection
17. *Peony – Paeonia, ALL – part sun, rich soil - (May Need Staking), protection
18. Iris, Crested – Iris cristada – shade, part shade/ moist soil, protection

PERENNIALS: (MEDIUM to TALL) – COMMON NAME – BOTANICAL – EXPOSURE

1. *Yarrow – *Achillea* 'Moonshine' – hot/dry sun, good drainage (READ **INVASIVE LIST)
2. *Daylily – *Hemerocallis* – sun/part shade, good drainage - (ALL but**HEMEROCALLIS FULVA)
3. *Lavender – *Lavandula*, ALL – hot/dry sun, good drainage
4. *Catmint – *Nepeta faassenii* – hot, sun, good drainage
5. *Sedum – *Sedum*, ALL – hot/dry, sun, part sun, good drainage
6. *Iris, Bearded - *Iris*, bearded, ALL – hot/dry sun, good drainage
7. *Iris, Siberian – *Iris*, siberica, ALL – sun/good drainage
8. *Russian Sage – *Perovskia atriplicifolia* 'Longin,' – hot, dry sun, good drainage – (May Need Staking)
9. *Phlox – *Phlox paniculata* 'Davidii,' 'Bright Eyes' – sun, rich soil, medium moisture
10. *Shasta Daisy – *Leucanthemum*, ALL – sun/part shade, medium moist soil, good drainage
11. *Sedum – *Sedum* – 'Frosty Morn,' sun/part sun, dry, good drainage
12. *Montauk Daisy – *Nipponanthemum nipponicum* – sun, good drainage
14. *Large Plantain Lily – *Hosta*, ALL large, quilted species – mostly shade, moist soil
15. *Hibiscus – *Hibiscus*, ALL – sun, medium soil – (Needs Staking)
16. *Astilbe – *Astilbe*, ALL - shade, rich, moist soil, moist soil – protection
17. *Iris, Japanese – *Iris ensata*, ALL – part shade, rich, moist soil – protection
18. Butterfly Milkweed – *Asclepias incarnate* 'Cinderella' – sun, medium soil
19. Wood Aster - *Aster novae angliae* – 'Alma Potschke' – sun, part sun, medium soil

GROUND COVERS: (EVERGREEN) – COMMON NAME - BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Periwinkle – *Vinca minor* 'Bowlsi' – shade, medium soil
2. *Sweet Flag Grass – *Acorus gramineus* 'Ogon' – part shade, medium moist soil, protection
3. *Pachysandra – *Pachysandra terminalis* – shade, moist soil, protection

GROUND COVERS: (DECIDUOUS/FLOWERING) – COMMON NAME – BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. Lemon Thyme – *Thymus citriodorus* – sun, good drainage
2. Pink Chintz Thyme – *Thymus serpyllum* – 'Pink Chintz Thyme'
3. *Low Phlox – *Phlox subulata*, "Emerald Blue, Emerald Pink' – sun, protection

GRASSES: (EVERGREEN SHORT) – COMMON NAME – BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Lilyturf, variegated– *Liriope variegata* – sun/part sun, good drainage
2. *Carex, variegated grass clump – *Carex morrowii* – part sun
3. *Japanese Forest Grass – *Hakonechloa macra*, 'Aureola' – shade, rich, moist soil, protection

GRASSES: (DECIDUOUS/SHORT) – COMMON NAME – BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. Fountain Grass – *Pennisetum* 'Little Bunny' – sun, good soil, drainage
2. Dwarf Maiden Grass – *Miscanthus sinensis* 'Little Kitten' – sun, good soil, drainage
3. *Black Mondo Grass – *Ophiopogon planiscapus* 'Ebony Knight' - shade, moist, rich soil

GRASSES: (DECIDUOUS/MEDIUM) – COMMON NAME – BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Fountain Grass – *Pennisetum* 'Hamlin,' 'Karley Rose' – sun, medium soil, good drainage
2. *Maiden Grass – *Miscanthus* 'Yaku Jima,' 'Adagio' – sun, medium soil, good drainage
3. *Oat Grass – *Helictotrichon sempervirens* – sun, medium soil, good drainage

GRASSES: (DECIDUOUS/ TALL) – COMMON NAME – BOTANICAL - EXPOSURE

1. *Fountain Grasses – *Pennisetum alopecuroides*, ALL – sun, good drainage – sun, medium soil
2. *Switch Grasses – *Panicum virgatum*, 'Heavy Metal,' 'Rotstrahlbusch' – sun, medium soil
3. *Maiden Grasses – *Miscanthus sinensis*, ALL – sun, medium soil (May Need Staking)
4. *Zebra Grasses – *Miscanthus sinensis* 'Zebrinus' – sun, medium soil
5. *Reed Grasses – *Calamagrostis x acutiflora* 'Overdam' – sun, medium soil
